Spiritual & Religious Sites

Pampa River - A holy river that pilgrims cross while en route to Sabarimala. The river is associated with several legends related to Lord Ayyappa.

Vavar Swamy Temple - A shrine dedicated to Vavar, a Muslim saint, revered by pilgrims at Sabarimala.

Sree Dharmasastha Temple, Pampa - A temple near the base of Sabarimala hill, dedicated to Lord Ayyappa.

Shabari Mala - The place where the legend of Shabari and Lord Rama is believed to have occurred, associated with the pilgrimage's mythology.

Nature & Scenic Spots

Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary - A vast sanctuary known for its wildlife, including elephants, tigers, and other species, offering trekking and boating opportunities.

Sabarimala Forests & Hills - A trek through the dense forest and hills offers scenic views and an opportunity for nature lovers to explore the rich biodiversity of the area.

Pandalam Palace - A royal palace in Pandalam, where Lord Ayyappa is believed to have spent his early years, now a major pilgrimage spot.

Sree Bhadrakali Temple, Kottur - A temple near Sabarimala, offering a serene environment with ancient rituals.
